GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility: MetroLALSA's 2020 Pa'lante Scholarship Award is open to all student members, regardless of racial or ethnic background, of the Latina/o Law Student Associations with MetroLALSA Delegates. In 2020, students from the following law schools are eligible to apply: Brooklyn Law, Cardozo Law, Columbia Law, CUNY Law, Fordham Law, Hofstra Law, NYLS, NYU Law, Pace Law, Rutgers Law, Seton Hall Law, St. John's Law, Touro Law. Applicants must be current law students, including those graduating in 2020.

<u>Selection</u>: Scholarship recipient(s) will be selected by an ad hoc Scholarship Committee comprised of MetroLALSA alumni.

<u>Criteria</u>: The Scholarship Committee will consider the following factors:

- 1. Community involvement/volunteer initiatives
- 2. Commitment to the Latino community
- 3. Academic Pursuits
- 4. Unique circumstances
- 5. Resume (two-page limit)
- 6. Personal Statement (750-word limit)
- 7. Letter of Recommendation *(optional)*

<u>Submission</u>: A completed application and supporting materials must be submitted via email to <u>metrolalsaorg@gmail.com</u> by Saturday, March 14, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. EDT.

Notification: Recipient(s) will be notified the week of March 23, 2020. Please note that recipient(s) are required to attend the 10th Annual Pa'lante Conference and Dinner Reception on Saturday, March 28, 2020 at New York Law School. Upon notification, please advise the Scholarship Committee as soon as practicable of any extenuating circumstance that prohibit attendance at the conference.

Award: MetroLALSA will disburse scholarship funds directly to the award recipient(s).

<u>Release</u>: Award recipient(s) agrees that by receiving scholarship monies, any photographs taken of the award recipient(s) at the 10th Annual Pa'lante Conference Award Ceremony may be used by MetroLALSA on the website, social media, newsletter or any other promotional materials.
