MetroLALSA strives to empower our communities, to increase diversity in the legal profession, and to develop Latina/o leaders.

Every year, MetroLALSA holds a conference that serves to educate and connect the Latina/o community.

MetroLALSA is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organized and coordinated entirely by students from the thirteen law schools in the New York and New Jersey Metropolitan area, with the help—and guidance of our alumni.





MetroLALSA Programming

For the past seven years, we have unified Latina/o law students in the NY and NJ metropolitan area to educate our communities, to establish a professional network, and to make a meaningful and positive impact in the legal profession.

Annual Conference

Every year, MetroLALSA hosts the Pa'lante Conference that gathered hundreds of attendees. Attendees include pre-law students, attorneys and local community organizations.

MetroLALSA established the Pipeline Program to introduce pre-law students and working professionals to the legal field and assist participants with the law school application process.

Scholarships

Sponsored over 50 students to attend other national conferences and awarded the annual Pa'lante Scholarship to law students for academic excellence.

MetroLALSA strives to empower Latina/o law students and provide the resources to pursue their legal careers.

The central concern for many students is securing their financial security while pursuing a legal education spanning thousands of dollars.

MetroLALSA offers scholarships to pipeline students, current law students and alums to attend professional conferences that will benefit their future career.

Over the years, MetroLALSA has sponsored students to attend the National Latina/o Law School Association's conference, Hispanic National Bar Association's convention, Proud To Be Latina's annual conferences and other national and local conferences. Thus far, MetroLALSA has sponsored over 50 law students, Pipeline students, and Alums.
